

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR VERIFYING YOUR VOTE

As promised, delegates have the ability to verify the vote they cast in each race at the GOP State Assembly.

You have two options:

### OPTION ONE

- At the State Convention, instructions were given from the stage to record the number on the front of your keypad along with the channel number. If you recorded both of these numbers, you can use option one to verify your vote.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU **\*MUST\*** HAVE RECORDED YOUR CHANNEL NUMBER TO VERIFY WITH THIS OPTION.
- Open the “Election Report” for the race you are verifying.
- At the top, you will see a list of candidates and the number they were assigned on the ballot, as well as the total number and percentage of votes cast for them.
- Under “Individual Voting Behavior,” you will be able to check the Channel Number and Keypad Number of your device, along with the number of your chosen candidate.
- The system recorded every vote entered and submitted, but only the last vote entered for a race was counted.

### OPTION TWO

- At the State Convention, instructions were given that another option was to record the number on the back of your keypad. If you recorded this, you can use option two to verify your vote.
- Open the “Log File” for the race you are verifying.
- At the top, you will see “Time,” “Keypad,” “Vote,” and “Authorized.”
- The Time is how many milliseconds after the voting was opened that your keypad’s vote was recorded.
- The Keypad is the number on the back of your device.
- The Vote is the number for your chosen candidate. You will need to refer to the Election Report (in Option One) to see the list of numbers assigned to each candidate in the race.
- Under “Authorized,” a “True” result means your vote was recorded.
- The system recorded every vote entered and submitted, but only the last vote entered for a race was counted.
